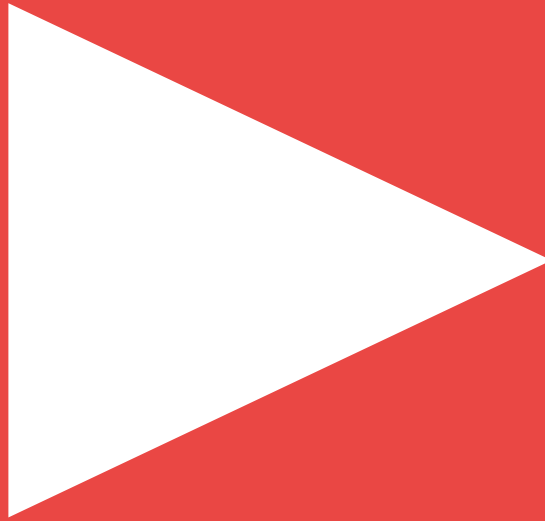

Mash Up
